Introduction

Welcome to our book study! Each week you will receive the study guide for the next chapter of the book. Each study guide has four components:

- the Anchor Text
- Guiding Questions
- Calls to Action
- the Personal Prayer

Anchor Texts are passages of scripture that capture the overall message of the chapter. We recommend reading the anchor text before beginning the chapter.

Guiding Questions are key questions that bring attention to important ideas or messages in the chapter. Guiding questions help to extend thinking so that the reader has clarity around what was read.

Each chapter contains several **Calls to Action** that exhort, encourage, and move the reader to act upon what was read. Calls to Action include questions to the reader, statements that compel the reader to make a change, or statements that bring the reader to a decision.

The **Personal Prayer** prompts the reader to talk to God about what was read. This includes asking for more understanding or revelation of what was read or asking for help to apply principles learned in the chapter.

Materials Needed

In order to get the most out of this book study, there are a few materials you should have readily available. *The Organic Gospel* is written to be compared side by side with the Word of God, so you will need your Bible. You will also need a notepad and pen so you can take notes and record your reflections.

3. In Genesis chapter 1, God creates each life type to reproduce after its own kind. How is this evident in creation?
4. The Bible paints the picture of two lineages that are in conflict; the lineage of Christ and the lineage of Satan.
 - a. What is evidence that Christ's seed has been sown in the human heart?
 - b. What is evidence that Satan's seed has been sown in the human heart?

The Woman's Seed & The Serpent's Seed

5. In Genesis chapter 3, Satan sowed seeds of corruption and rebellion in Adam and Eve that mutated their God-given nature. What was the result of this mutation?
6. Why did Jesus have to die such a brutal and dramatic death?
7. How is salvation organic?

Call to Action

List one to two specific Calls to Action from this chapter that resonate with you.

Personal Prayer

Once you finish studying this chapter, take the time to pray and ask the Lord to continue to teach you about His organic nature through His Word and to clarify any areas where you may have questions. Ask Him to show you how what you have read applies to your life and the practical steps needed to respond to the Calls to Action that you identified.
